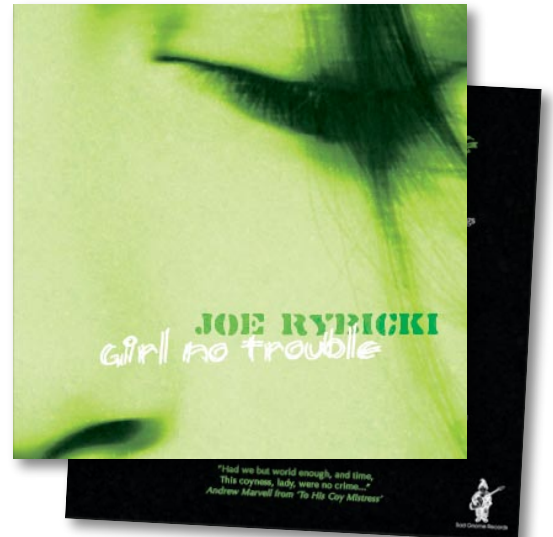

At last; one we've been wanting to do for ages: **Sad Gnome Records** is damn proud to announce their latest (4th) release: **Joe Rybicki's "Girl No Trouble"**. A debut single, Pop good and proper in its melodies and subject matter, yet unconventional in its format; a kind of 'concept single', its two tracks, "Girl No Trouble" and "Rosie", are set at opposite ends of the same love affair, with both phases bringing their own, distinctly different, yet equally inevitable frustrations.

Joe Rybicki was born sometime in the late 1980s, in a town somewhere near Manchester, the only child of a clogmaker and a librarian. A chance encounter with a banjo and a scratched Meat Loaf LP led to him being forever enchanted with music. His mother brought home discarded library books for him to read, which he did. The real world never quite lived up to the expectations he developed from delving into these literary realms, so he began constructing an existence in his own words.

You'll be able to witness these two worlds collide when Joe takes his show on the road to promote "Girl No Trouble". He sometimes performs solo, and sometimes with a somewhat fluid line-up of relatives, groupies and hangers-on, and has built up a reputation for his entertaining live performances, appearing on bills with acts such as **The Holloways**, **Babyshambles**, **John Otway** and **The View**.
